ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE SEASON

REHEARSALS

Commitment: As a reminder, every student participating in the concert signed a form stating that they are committed to be in the show and will be in class and at all of the rehearsals. If your child will be absent due to a planned activity, please give us notice in writing. If your child is sick, please call into the studio. *Students with excessive absences will not be allowed to perform.* Please make every effort to have your children at rehearsals so they will be ready to perform to the best of their ability.

Full Run-Throughs and Dress Rehearsals: These allow the students to become familiar with the show order, theater surroundings, costumes, and being on stage. Lighting, music cues, set changes, and all other logistics for an organized and professional performance are rehearsed. We run organized and timely rehearsals and your help with the process will guarantee a professional and pleasant production.

Call Times: Performers are expected to check-in by the posted "call time".

Video and Photography: Parents may videotape or shoot photographs of their children at the Dress Rehearsals. No video or flash photography will be allowed in the theater during performances.

Practice! Practice! Practice!

Students are encouraged to rehearse their dances at home. A CD with your child's music is available for \$5. Order forms are at the front desk. Also, if preferred, you can come to rehearsal and video the dances. This would give you a great rehearsal aid at home.

COSTUMES

Hair and Makeup: Required hairstyles and makeup will be sent home prior to Dress Rehearsal. Makeup is required for the Stage Dress Rehearsal and for the Performances. It is optional for the Photo Shoot. Basic Makeup—Eyes: Black Mascara, brown eye shadow and eyeliner. Cheeks & Lips: Red blush and lipstick (browns look black on stage). Some characters may be asked for different makeup based on their costumes. More details will be sent soon.

Rented Costumes: Many costumes and props will be provided by Wasatch Ballet. These costumes will be kept in possession of WBC and will not be allowed to be taken home for any reason. If any portion of these costumes are lost or damaged due to neglect, performer will be liable for the cost of the item.

Personal Costumes: For some of the dances, it will be requested that dancers help provide portions of their costumes. In these cases, the items will be something that the performers may already have at home or could borrow. More details will be sent soon.

Tights, Shoes, and Camisoles: Required tights and shoes will be posted at the studio and will also be sent home with the Costume Instructions. *If you do not own the required shoes, please talk with us about the possibility of borrowing some.* Tights need to be in great repair with no holes or stains. Ballet shoes need to be clean, with elastics sewn. Tap shoe ribbons should be replaced with a piece of black elastic sewn together, avoiding untied shoes during performances. Older students who have costume changes may prefer to wear a flesh colored camisole leotard under their costumes. This allows them to make quick changes in the shared dressing room. REHEARSALS:

- You will not perform if you do not attend & are not excused
- You must remain until excused, NO EXCEPTIONS
- PLEASE KEEP NON-DANCING SIBLINGS AT HOME

FULL RUN-THROUGHS & STUDIO DRESS REHEARSALS—

What to expect: At the studio, we will run the entire show making stops when necessary. While not dancing, students will sit in the studio and watch the others. This is very fun and productive! For dress rehearsals, dancers should wear required hair, shoes, and tights. Also, costumes provided by dancers are required.

What to expect:

EVERYONE: Arrive at the studio at the required time with required hair and makeup. DO NOT BE LATE! All students will be in the group photo. Individual photos will only be taken for children who have prepaid. Photo shoot should take 30 minutes to one hour. *Please keep non-dancing siblings at home!*

DRESS REHEARSAL AT SCERA

What to expect: Arrive at Scera with required hair and makeup at scheduled time. Please enter through the Southeast doors. We will run the show in order, including the finale. Then, we will rerun certain dances which need more lighting, spacing, or other help. Students must stay until they are excused. While waiting to dance, Dancers may sit in audience and watch the others. This is very fun and educational.

THINGS TO DO **BEFORE THE CONCERT**

SIGN UP TO VOLUNTEER

In order to keep production costs down, we greatly rely on your help throughout the performance season. *We request every family to have someone volunteer at least once.* We need mothers, fathers, or anyone capable to help during Dress Rehearsals and Performances.

Volunteers will receive a \$5 credit voucher for each time they help.
Vouchers can be redeemed after the volunteer shift or a \$5 credit will be applied to your account. *You must turn in a Credit Voucher in order to receive a discount.*

DESCRIPTION OF NEEDED TASKS

STAGE ASSISTANTS: Help the Stage Manager get the students and/or props on and off the stage and/or help check dancers in and out. If you are able to help at more than one show, or all of them, it would be great (but not required).

STRONG ASSISTANTS: Help the Stage Manager backstage with scenery, props etc. This is great for Dads, strong moms and older siblings.

CHAPERONES: Needed for the Children's Roles helping with costumes, change of shoes, getting class on and off stage, and watching them in the Green Room between dances. Chaperones are unable to leave students to watch dances from audience. There is a "Green Room" where the children will play quietly and watch videos while waiting to dance.

ADDITIONAL HELPERS: Needed during Full Run-throughs and Dress Rehearsals.

FLOWERS: Assemble flower bouquets prior to the performance.
*Need to volunteer all three nights to receive discount voucher.

PERFORMANCES

Community Outreach Performances: **January 9-12**

What to expect: For your assigned Outreach performances, arrive at Outreach location at required Call Time. Show will be approximately 45 minutes long. Dancers will need to be picked up promptly from Outreach location when show is over.

Remember: Dancers will NOT perform at ALL Outreach Performances. PERFORMANCE ASSIGNMENTS (CASTING) WILL BE POSTED BY DECEMBER 12TH

SCERA Center for the Arts: **January 19, 20, and 21**

What to expect: Arrive at required Call Time. Please enter through the Southeast doors. Check in at the Check-in Desk. While not performing, participants will stay in dressing rooms and green room with Parent Volunteers. Dancers are not allowed to watch the performance or go into the lobby. All performers are involved in the finale. After the finale, dancers will be taken back to the Green Room where they will wait for a parent to check them out.

- ***SCERA Theater will not allow audience members into the theater prior to 6:30.***
- ***Saving seats is not allowed prior to 6:30.***
- ***Children under 3 are not allowed.***
