Dress Code Reminder BUNS REQUIRED!

Dress Codes are an important ballet tradition and aspect of dance training which allows the teacher to see the dancers' technique. Baggy clothes, skirts, and legwarmers might hide potential problems such as bent knees, sway backs, and general technique errors. Please help your child to remember! The Dress Code is listed below.

FOR ALL CLASSES:

Long hair must be pulled away from the face and worn in a bun (if hair is long enough). Short hair must be pulled away from the face.

CHILDREN'S CLASSES

Dance Exp, Exp Combo, Combo & Ballet Basics: Any color of leotard and tights. Pink ballet shoes (canvas split sole preferred) and tap shoes (for combo classes) are recommended. Hair pulled away from the face.

JR & SR CLASSES

JAZZ: Any color of tights, leotards, or jazz pants (t-shirt for boys). No jeans or baggy clothes. Soft jazz shoes (split sole)

BALLET: Black leotard, pink tights, soft pink ballet shoes (canvas split sole). Hair in a bun. No skirts or shorts.
